Culinary Arts Training

Our students learn food sanitation and safety for the food service industry. A hands-on approach in our industrial kitchen, alongside experienced chefs, in addition to classroom instruction, give our students the edge in this growing market. They receive on-thejob experience through paid internships. Graduates of this program go on to work in all types of restaurants, for catering companies and franchises.

Young Adult Internship Program

Participants choose from a large range of internship options in both the public and private sector. Participants gain on-the-job skills to work in customer service, retail, human resources, and many other exciting careers!

Opportunity Youth

Participants attend ABE and/or HSE classes while simultaneously interning at sites and exploring career options.

College Bound

Participants receive individualized assistance to make well-informed decisions on higher education, and to ensure that their education plans coincide with their future careers.
